## Arsenal World of Sport



For generations of Gooners a visit to Arsenal World of Sport shop at Finsbury Park has been a must.

When a major £300K refurbishment was planned during summer 2008 the Club called on their regular team of consultants and contractors to make sure the Project went to plan.

The work involved a complete re-fit of all fixtures, fittings and partitioning; up-grade of Mechanical and Electrical services and a new glazed shop front and supporting structure.

Work commenced at the end of the 2007-08 Season and had to be complete in time for the new Arsenal strip launch in July.

World of Sport is located in a very busy part of north London and so some of the work, including complex lifting manoeuvres, had to be scheduled out of hours to minimise impact on this major transport hub.

### Health & Safety and CDM

All issues of health & safety and CDM compliance were carefully assessed and all team members co-operated to ensure safe working practices were maintained throughout the project. Relevant information was collated and passed to designers and contractors.

A user-friendly Health & Safety File was prepared in conjunction with Claremont Construction (the Principal Contractor) and issued at the end of the Contract.

Careful liaison was also planned with Transport for London to ensure any operational issues were tackled.

Despite some delays beyond the control of the Project Team the work was completed within time-frame and budget.

The store opened in time for the new kit launch and the much improved facilities are appreciated by staff and visitors alike.
